





It is enough to understand numbers to realize the scale of the war in Ukraine. There were 41.1 million Ukrainians at the beginning of February 2022 - as indicated by the country's statistical services. Now we are 34.5 million. And the counter is constantly moving backward.

Every Ukrainian family has been forced to seek shelter from the war, even those far from the front line. 3,000 rockets and hundreds of drones have been fired at almost every corner of the country within a short time. These have been over 250 days of continuous air-raid sirens that last from a few minutes to 10-15 hours. Instead of learning poems, our children have learned well the names of missiles - Caliber, Iskander, and Tornado. Their childhood has changed since February 24: it is now on pause.






Fleeing the war, 6.65 million Ukrainians found themselves abroad. Almost 4 million women and children applied for long-term refuge in Europe. But the most horrifying fact is that nearly 20,000 Ukrainian civilians have already lost their lives in this war — more than 500 children among them. Hundreds of thousands of people have been injured.






Ukraine - is 603,628 km² of land, famous for its history, traditions, culture, beauty, fertility, and progressiveness. During the first seven years of the war, 7% of Ukrainian territory was occupied. And within just one month since February 24, 2022, more than 20% of the country was seized occupation. Nearly 1,600 cities and towns have been liberated ever since, but the occupation did not go without a trace for them.







In just six months of the war, Ukraine suffered damages of \$113.5 billion. The minimum estimated sum for the restoration has already exceeded \$200 billion. This is almost 20,000 apartment blocks and 116,000 private houses, more than 2,100 educational institutions (261 schools have been completely destroyed), almost 1,000 medical institutions (127 hospitals have been completely destroyed), more than 800 kindergartens, thousands of cultural buildings, and more than 400 enterprises. The Ukrainian economy has shrunk by 40% and inflation of 30% has become a new reality and besides the overall increase in consumer prices, Ukrainians are facing shortages due to logistical disruptions - there is a lack fuel, equipment, and even ordinary salt.





The onset of winter is a worrisome for everyone today, considering the hours-long daily blackouts throughout the country. 40% of Ukraine's energy system has been destroyed. Until recently, Ukraine was producing enough electricity to sell to European countries, but today, due to the constant missile attacks, it can barely provide light and heat for its own people.






However, 34.5 million Ukrainians are still at home. They met the hardships of war face to face and did not break but became strong.



It is a very substantial figure - comparable to the entire population of New York - the most populated city in the USA. To add perspective, that's approximately the number of people living in Finland and Estonia combined. That is a lot, and yet not enough - because millions of Ukrainians still need help.




Together with you, we distributed 28,000 tons of aid.




